May is Electrical Safety Month, and your team at North Star Electric knows you're aware of the big rules of electrical safety stay away from downed power lines, don't overload an outlet and keep electrical devices away from water. But there may be additional safety precautions you could take, and here is one tip to help keep your family safe.

Tip: be quicker to stop the flicker

If you are noticing flickering lighting in any of your home's rooms, don't assume it is just a bulb starting to burn out. It could indicate you have a damaged electrical panel that needs replacing, or you have too many appliances plugged into a single circuit.



HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE BOARDROOM

These are the highlights from the March 3, 2021, regular board meeting. All board members were in attendance. In addition to routine actions, the board voted to approve RUS forms allowing General Manager Josh Compton to execute and submit RUS forms on behalf of North Star, to add General Manager Josh Compton to the check-signing authority, to submit an application for a matching grant to the CoBank Sharing Success program, to accept the 2020 annual cogeneration filings and reports and to move the April 7, 2021, board meeting to March 24, 2021.

Staff reports included the safety report, the financial report, review of the 2020 RUS Form 7, G&T (generation and transmission) capital credits, the CoBank Sharing Success program, load control, ripple receiver inspections and repairs, rebates, new solar installations, off-peak installations, Littlefork office roof repairs, Baudette building maintenance, pole changeouts, the County Road 14 work plan job near Williams, bids for 2021 construction projects, vehicles for sale by bid, and outages (556-45-005-07, Doug Franz).

Darrick Moe, President and CEO of the Minnesota Rural Electric Association (MREA), joined the meeting via Zoom. He discussed current legislative issues concerning cooperatives.

Detailed minutes are available at the cooperative for member review. Regular board meetings are generally held the first Wednesday of every month. If you wish to speak with the board or have an item that you would like to have placed on the agenda, please contact the co-op at least two weeks in advance to be included on the agenda.

- 1.25 oz. envelope taco seasoning

- 8 oz. can crescent dinner rolls
- 1 cup tortilla chips (crushed)
- 2 cups shredded cheddar cheese

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- 2. Brown ground beef and onion; drain.
- Add back to frying pan and stir in taco seasoning, tomato sauce and refried beans; mix well.
- Press unrolled crescent dough onto bottom and up the sides of 9" pan.
- 5. Sprinkle 3/4 cup crushed chips into prepared pie pan.

- 6. Spread beef mixture over chips.
- 7. Bake for 15 minutes.
- 8. Add shredded cheese and top with remaining chips.
- 9. Bake 15 minutes longer or until crust is brown.
