



### **HOME COOKING**

#### **Pork Fried Rice**

A quick, flavorful and satisfying way to transform rice into a complete meal for a winning dish that the whole family will enjoy.

Prep Time 10 mins Cook Time 15 mins **Total Time** 25 mins

Servings

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 1 Tbsp butter
- 6 ounces ground pork (or chicken)
- 1 green onion, chopped
- ¼ cup carrot, chopped
- ¼ cup frozen peas
- 1 egg, beaten

- 1 cup cold cooked rice
- 1½ Tbsp soy sauce
- 1/8 tsp garlic powder
- 1/2 tsp ground ginger

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Melt butter in skillet over medium heat. Add ground pork, green onion, carrot and peas. Cook until pork is cooked through.
- 2. Stir egg into skillet and scramble. Add rice, soy sauce, garlic powder and ground ginger.
- 3. Cook and stir until heated through and serve.
- \* This recipe makes about 2 servings. Feel free to double the recipe, or substitute ground chicken for pork.
