



COMPRESSED AIR INCENTIVES APPLICATION

The following information is provided as part of the PowerSavers conservation program to encourage non-residential customers to select and install energy-efficient equipment for their facilities. This program is a joint offering from participating utilities of the Minnkota Power Cooperative (MPC) and the Northern Municipal Power Agency (NMPA).

Instructions for Use:

For complete instructions, please refer to the Terms and Conditions on page 4.

Step 1: Determine Eligibility. Equipment must be new and installed in a facility served by one of the participating municipals or cooperatives listed on page 2. Incentives may vary by utility. Please refer to your member cooperative or municipal system before submitting your rebate applications.

Step 2: Install New Equipment. New equipment must be installed and old equipment removed. Product types eligible for incentives are listed on this form. If there is a question regarding eligibility, please consult with your local cooperative or municipal.

Step 3: Contact your local cooperative or municipal for pre-approval if the potential incentive is greater than \$15,000. Maximum incentive of \$50,000 per member/customer per year. Incentives are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Step 4: Complete and sign the application. Forms must be received within 60 days of installation. Incomplete applications will cause delays in payment.

Step 5: Attach the documentation. Include manufacturer (OEM) specification sheets and itemized invoices detailing costs for both the equipment installed, and for the installation labor. The equipment invoice must indicate date of purchase, size, type, make, model and total project cost.

Step 6: Mail completed paperwork to your utility, listed on page 2 of this form. Incentives are subject to change or termination without notice at the discretion of the participating utilities.

No-loss Condensate Drains	Drain must continuously monitor the level of condensate and drain it without leaking compressed air. Manual or timed drains are not eligible.		\$130/drain		
Low Pressure Drop Filters	Compressed air system's horsepower must be ≥ 50 hp. Rebates are for replacing standard coalescing filters with low pressure drop filters (mist eliminators).		\$6/hp		
Cycling Refrigerated Dryers	Rebates are available for replacing refrigerated, non-cycling, compressed air dryers with efficient refrigerated dryers. New dryer may use cycling thermal mass, variable speed or digital scroll technology. May be free-standing or integral to the air compressor as a factory-installed option.		\$0.09/CFM		
Compressed Air Storage ≤ 1 gal/cfm to >3 gal/cfm	Rebates are available for the installation of a compressed air storage tank to augment the capacity of trim (not base load) compressors. Tank must be supplied by rotary screw compressors operating at greater than 90 pound-force per square inches (psig). Storage capacity must be increased from current gal/CFM of the trim compressor. Installation of tanks to support base-loaded compressors are not eligible.		\$35/hp of trim compressor		
Compressed Air Storage ≤ 3 gal/cfm to >5 gal/cfm			\$16/hp of trim compressor		
VSD Air Compressor ≤50hp, Single Shift (8/5)	Back-up and redundant air compressors are not eligible for this rebate. Air compressors must operate new VSD air compressor 1,976 hours per year to be eligible for this rebate.		\$20/hp		
VSD Air Compressor ≤50hp, 2 Shifts (16/5)	Back-up and redundant air compressors are not eligible for this rebate. Air compressors must operate new VSD air compressor 3,952 hours per year to be eligible for this rebate.		\$40/hp		
VSD Air Compressor ≤50hp, 3 Shifts 24/5)	Back-up and redundant air compressors are not eligible for this rebate. Air compressors must operate new VSD air compressor 5,928 hours per year to be eligible for this rebate.		\$60/hp		
VSD Air Compressor ≤50hp, 4 Shifts 24/7)	Back-up and redundant air compressors are not eligible for this rebate. Air compressors must operate new VSD air compressor 8,320 hours per year to be eligible for this rebate		\$80/hp		

Note: Only one compressor on a compressed air system (connected by piping) can qualify for this VFD rebate. Other systems may qualify for a custom rebate.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **Incentive Offer:** Projects must be implemented (completed) by **Dec. 31, 2026**. An original signed application and invoices for materials and labor must be delivered to the participating utility at the address located on page 2 of this application **within 60 calendar days of installation (completion)**. Please keep a copy for your records.
2. **Proof of Purchase:** This application must have complete information and be submitted with an invoice itemizing the **new equipment purchased and the manufacturer (OEM) specification sheets**. The invoice must indicate date of purchase, size, type, make, model and total project cost.
3. **Compliance:**
 - a. All projects are expected to comply with federal, state and local codes.
 - b. All equipment must be new or retrofitted with new components per the program specifications. Used or rebuilt equipment is not eligible for incentives. Existing equipment must be removed or permanently disconnected.
 - c. Equipment must meet specification requirements and be purchased and operating prior to submitting an incentive application.
 - d. Customers may only receive one incentive per piece of qualifying equipment.
 - e. If the project is in a leased building, the term of the lease must be at least five (5) years.
4. **Payment:** Once completed paperwork is submitted, incentive payments are usually made within 45 calendar days. Incomplete applications will either delay payments or be denied. The participating utilities reserve the right to refuse payment and participation if the customer or contractor violates program rules and procedures. All projects exceeding \$15,000 of incentives will be inspected prior to incentive payment.
5. **Inspection:** Program staff may conduct an inspection of the facility to survey installed projects.
6. **Publicity:** The participating utilities reserve the right to publicize your participation in this program, unless you specifically request otherwise.
7. **Program Discretion:** Incentives are available on a first-come, first-served basis. This incentive is subject to change or termination without notice at the discretion of the participating utilities.
8. **Logo Use:** Customers or allies may not use the participating utilities' name or logo in any marketing, advertising, or promotional material without written permission.
9. **Disclaimers:** The participating utilities
 - a. Do not endorse any particular manufacturer, product, labor or system design by offering these programs;
 - b. Will not be responsible for any tax liability imposed on the customer as a result of the payment of incentives;
 - c. Do not expressly or implicitly warrant the performance of installed equipment or contractors' quality of work (contact your contractor for detailed warranties);
 - d. Are not responsible for the proper disposal/recycling of any waste generated as a result of this project;
 - e. Are not liable for any damage caused by the installation of the equipment or for any damage caused by the malfunction of the installed equipment.

INCENTIVE LIMIT

Maximum incentive of \$50,000 per member/customer per year. Total incentive not to exceed 50 percent of material plus external labor costs.
